

SFI - Swedish for Immigrants

Alma Folkhögskola's courses in *Swedish for Immigrants (SFI)* are intended for people whose mother tongue is other than Swedish.

Our teachers have extensive experience from teaching SFI and the fact that they are both native and nonnative speakers increases their ability to provide language support in various languages and is a great advantage while meeting people with different cultural background.

You can study SFI in learning paths 2 and 3 at levels B, C and D at Alma Folkhögskola in Göteborg. We offer you 15 hours classroom teaching per week. In addition to this you can also study on your own at our premises. You can practice reading, writing, listening and speaking. You will also learn about the Swedish society, culture and working life.

We will make field trips to various places in Göteborg to practice the language in everyday situations.

At Alma Folkhögskola you will receive identical SFI-courses and the same grades as if you would take the SFI-courses offered by the Municipality of Göteborg.

There is no waiting list to Alma Folkhögskola; you can start right away.

How do I apply to SFI at Alma Folkhögskola Göteborg?

You need to fill out the application form. If you need help, please visit the school's administration office on Örngatan 6 in Göteborg.

The next step for you is to visit the Student Guidance Centre (Studievägledningen) at Rosenlundsplatsen 2. You need to show a valid ID and tell that you wish to study SFI at Alma Folkhögskola,

They will confirm that you are qualified to attend the course and you will be asked to carry out a test to make sure you'll be starting at the right level.

The school will then contact you and inform you when the classes start.

Important information about studying SFI:

- You can apply from July 1st the year you turn 20.
- You must have a Swedish personal identity number (personnummer) or a European citizenship.
- You need a birth certificate or valid ID card when you register.
